From The Edge

‘Our location is unique. It provides water and air, the two essential ingredients which come together to create Dingle Whiskey .

We source our water from a well located 240 feet below our Distillery. Water is vital, without water there is no whiskey. In the beginning it creates the spirit and when the time comes the Master Distiller uses it to fine tune the nature and flavour of the final whiskey.

The air breathes life into the casks as they mature in Dingle. The fresh, mild, moist air provides the ideal climate to ensure our casks develop complexity and character as each month and year passes.’





The Wren's Day Tradition in Dingle has been continuous, it is the only Wren's Day on the island that has never stopped.

Thus, it reminds us that we are here to stay. It's our symbol of strength and our link to the past.

It deeply roots us into the Dingle tradition.

Like Wrens Day, Whiskey Making is an ancient tradition that has never stopped and one we are proud to be part of. The Wren Boy, just like Dingle Distillery is here to stay.

Explained

Alcohol By Volume:

It is the standard measurement, used worldwide, to assess the strength of a particular beverage. Whiskey must have a minimum alcohol content of 40% ABV.

In USA Proof is the measurement and is defined as twice the alcohol measurement. 40% ABV would be 80 Proof.

Triple-distilled:

Whiskey that is Triple Distilled, must be distilled three times, usually in copper pot stills. It's a more expensive process than double-distillation or continuous distillation.

Non Age Statement:

Our Single Malt has no age statement. Although it is a marriage of whiskey matured in different casks aged between 5 and 7 years old



Explained

Non Chill Filtered:

Whiskey that has not undergone chill filtration, which consists of being cooled and passed through a filter in order to remove particles.

We don't use Chill Filtering as long-chain esters—large molecules which contribute to a whiskey's flavour and mouthfeel—are also filtered out in the process.

Spirits above 46% do not need to be chill-filtered.

Explained

Hand-Cut:

- Bringing the stills gently into the spirit safe by adjusting the steam flow rate by hand.
- Ensuring the spirit runs cool in in the safe by balancing the flow rate and condenser cooling.
- Making the spirit cuts in the spirit safe by hand using hydrometers.
- Reducing the final spirit strength by hand, before filling into cask.
- Selecting the best casks by taste and nose to marry together for each release.



At Dingle 'Hand Cut' is all about the human touch. Taking pride and care in what we do to ensure that the spirit we create is a credit to the Distillery and the wider community. Making the cut is key but there is no compromise at Dingle – when the time is right, the time is right.
